# J-TEENS CODE OF CONDUCT

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST SHOW RESPECT TO ONE ANOTHER AND TO ACCEPT INDIVIDUALS' DIFFERENCES OF OPINION, SKILL, AND BACKGROUND. THIS CODE OF CONDUCT CLEARLY DEFINES HOW WE AS A CAMP COMMUNITY CAN ENHANCE THE EXPERIENCE FOR OURSELVES AS WELL AS FOR OTHERS AROUND US.

- As a representative of JCC Rockland, J-Teens are expected to behave in an acceptable manner at all times. Anyone who causes any personal or property damage will be liable to pay the cost of the damage. J-Teens are expected to show respect to all other campers, staff and the environment. Respect means to honor and show consideration and value to people, property, the environment, and oneself. It means to treat others well even if they look, act, or behave differently than you do.
- Inappropriate sexual behavior including but not limited to; sexual harassment, inappropriate touching, sexting or verbal sexual remarks will not be tolerated. Verbal, emotional, and/or physical abuse or bullying will not be tolerated.
- Physical abuse such as hitting, kicking, biting, spitting, slapping, pushing, grabbing, etc.,
   will not be allowed and can result in immediate dismissal from camp.
- Appropriate language must be used at all times. No swearing.
- Smoking or vaping is not permitted at any time.
- The consumption of alcohol and the use of drugs is strictly prohibited. If any J-Teen is
  observed to be under the influence, he or she will be dismissed from the program and
  the parent or guardian must pick up the J-Teen immediately. There will be no refunds issued.
- Weapons of any kind or anything that resembles a weapon are not allowed. This includes but
  is not limited to: weapons, firearms, explosives, paintball guns, BB guns, pocket knives, tasers,
  toy weapons, darts/dartboards, martial arts equipment, and lighters.
- All J-Teens are responsible for keeping the bus clean. Food and drink on the bus is a privilege
  and if the bus becomes messy the privilege will be taken away.
- Everyone is responsible for their own personal property. JCC Rockland will not be held responsible for any lost, damaged or stolen items.
- Everyone must show respect by listening to and following the directions given by the camp staff.
- Arguing or challenging the authority of camp staff members is not accepted.
- J-Teens may use cell phones and smart watches on the bus, during drop off and dismissal, and when appropriate on trips. If there are any cases of cyberbullying, inappropriate texts or pictures, or any other inappropriate use of cell phones or smart watches, we will revoke the privilege of using these devices during the camp day.

## J-TEENS CODE OF CONDUCT

WHILE WE UNDERSTAND THAT NO LIST OF BEHAVIORS COULD EVER BE COMPLETE, THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS ARE SET AS CONSEQUENCES TO UNACCEPTABLE BEHAVIORS FOR J-TEENS.

### **1ST OCCURRENCE**

Will result in a conference with the J-Teen and a telephone call to parents. For smoking, drugs, alcohol, and weapons, a 1st occurrence will result in immediate expulsion from camp without a refund. This "zero tolerance" policy will require parents to immediately pick up their child from the program.

## **2ND OCCURRENCE**

Will result in a conference with the J-Teen and their parents/guardians. Depending on the circumstance, a suspension or expulsion may occur without refund. Final determination is made by the Camp Director.

### **3RD OCCURRENCE**

Will result in immediate expulsion from camp without refund. Parents will be required to immediately pick up their child.

JCC Rockland reserves the right to terminate or suspend any J-Teen. JCC Rockland also reserves the right to deny a J-Teen participation in any activity if his or her behavior is deemed unsatisfactory and not in the best interest of the J-Teen or the camp.
